1. Purpose

In this instance your data is being processed for the specific purpose of selling your property, for which you have instructed us to act on your behalf.

2. Lawful Basis

The collection of your data for this purpose is under the *Lawful Basis* of Contract, because we require this information to facilitate the sale of your property.

3. Information Collected

The personal data we will collect and process about you in connection with this purpose is:

- 3.1. Name
- 3.2. Address (both for the property and correspondence if they are different)
- 3.3. Telephone number(s)
- 3.4. Email Address
- 3.5. Proof of Identification (for Anti-Money Laundering purposes)
- 3.6. Proof of Address (for Anti-Money Laundering purposes)

In addition to which, we will also collect non-personal data regarding the property to be sold.

4. Retention

Under the *Lawful Basis* referenced in paragraph 2, your data will be retained until the end of the financial year in which you complete any sale and for a further 6 years after that in order to comply with HMRC requirements regarding financial record keeping and anti-money laundering regulations. This retention period will commence from the date of the completion of the sale.

5. Destruction

At the end of this retention period your data will be destroyed using an approved method unless prevented by Court order.

6. Data Sharing

Whilst we control your personal data we will need to share this data with the following parties, for the following purposes, in order to provide you with the services you are seeking from us:

- 6.1. Estates IT Ltd for the sole purpose of maintaining a consumer database so we can provide you with our service.
- 6.2. Cortec IT Solutions Ltd for the sole purpose of storing our Company's electronic data (consumer database and associated records).
- 6.3. The Purchaser of your property.
- 6.4. The Purchaser's legal advisers for the sole purpose of executing the contract for the purchase. The details of this firm will be made known to you in the Memorandum of Sale, which will be issued to you at the point the purchase is agreed, (subject to contract).

- 6.5. Your legal advisers for the purpose of executing the contract for the sale.
- 6.6. The purchaser's surveyor, for the sole purpose of surveying the property in connection with the purchase. As we do not yet know the identity of this property professional, they will be made known to you at the time of the survey if we need to share your personal details with them in order to facilitate the survey.
- 6.7. Any other Estate Agents involved in the "chain" of property sales / purchases associated with your purchase.

- 6.8. The Property Ombudsman for the sole purpose of administering any investigation by them.
- 6.9. The Company's insurers, Hiscox for the sole purpose of defending any claim brought against the Company.
- 6.10. The Company's legal advisers, (who are not retained, but whose details will be provided to you in the event that you commence proceedings against the Company,) for the sole purpose of defending any claim.

7. Rights of the Data Subject
